

- MICROSOFT WORD CAN DEFINETELY MAKE OUR TEXT DOCUMENTS LOOK NICE, IT HAS MORE FONTS THAN NOTEPAD, LET'S YOU USE COLOURS AND LOTS MORE COOL STUFF.
- DUT MICROSOFT WORD ADDS LOTS OF HIDDEN STUFF TO YOUR DOCUMENT THAT TELLS HOW THE DOCUMENT SHOULD BE DISPLAYED, IF YOU MAKE A HTML DOCUMENT IN MICROSOFT WORD ALL OF THIS HIDDEN STUFF GETS ADDED TO YOUR DOCUMENT.
