## For Pygame Zero open a Command Prompt and type: pip install pgzero

To Open Command Prompt in Windows 10

- Select the Start button.
- 2. Type cmd.
- 3. Click or tap Command Prompt from the list.

## **Older Windows**

- 1. Click Start (Windows XP) or the Start button (Windows 7 or Vista).
- 2. Click All Programs, followed by Accessories.
- 3. Choose Command Prompt from the list of programs.

I have some image and sound files on a USB for you.

- 1. Go to the *cda pygame zero* folder and open it.
- 2. Right click on game\_1.py, then click on edit with Idle



When game\_1.py opens up you will see 2 lines of code import pgzrun and pgzrun.go() these allow us to run our code in Idle and should remain at the top and bottom of our code.

Type the following lines of code.

```
alien = Actor('alien')
alien.topright = 100, 10
WIDTH = 500
HEIGHT = alien.height + 20
def draw():
    screen.clear()
    alien.draw()
```

```
def update():
    alien.left += 2
    if alien.left > WIDTH:
        alien.right = 0
```

```
def on_mouse_down(pos):
    if alien.collidepoint(pos):
        alien.image = 'alien_hurt'
        sounds.eep.play()
```

```
def set_alien_hurt():
    alien.image = 'alien_hurt'
    sounds.eep.play()
    clock.schedule_unique(set_alien_normal, 1.0)

def set_alien_normal():
    alien.image = 'alien'
```

```
def on_mouse_down(pos):
    if alien.collidepoint(pos):
        set_alien_hurt()
```
